The second project «Strengthening Network for Education, Research and Innovation in Environmental Health in Asia» / TUTORIAL 2016-2020 is sponsored by European Commission ERASMUS Plus program become a continuation of the first international project.

Impact on institutional level

Sustainable relations between the European Union and Kyrgyzstan were demonstrated by the signing of a new Enhanced Partnership and Cooperation Agreement in July 2019. Under the Erasmus+ programme, Capacity building in the field of higher education - Key action 2 component is of particular importance for the continuation of systemic reforms in higher education.
